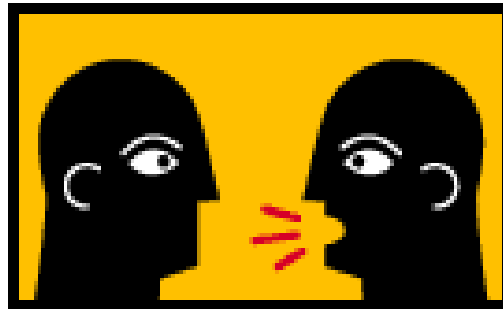


Date for your Diary 2010
